Pleiades Red Blend, Marin County *Old vine blend. Incredibly drinkable, goes with anything.*
Sirius Petit Sirah, Mendocino *Soft & supple, yet packed with dark fruits, pepper, & spice.*
Andromeda Pinot Noir, Marin County *Nicasio Pinot Noir vines. Very cool & windy conditions.*
Orion Rossi Vineyard, St. Helena *Very old vines. Intensely aromatic with exceptional depth.*

2017 Rosé *A true Provencal-style Rosé, produced from Grenache Noir & Mourvedre grapes the original cuttings for which were brought over from Chateauneuf-du-Pape. Dry, crisp, simply parfait*
2014 Grenache *A dark, full bodied wine showing the classic Rhone character of raspberry liqueur, licorice, pepper, & spice. Powerful and complex, you would think it came straight from the Rhone Valley.*
2016 Barbera *This deep colored Barbera is full of exotic fruit, spice, and floral aromas. Juicy in the mouth, 2015 was one of the most concentrated vintages produced.*
2016 Zinfandel *Intense fruits, tannin, and acidity, this vintage is classic Dry Creek Zinfandel. Dark and full-bodied while remaining bright and fresh. A favorite!*

2013 Brut Rouge *A lovely bubbly rosé of merlot. Crisp & dry with citrusy aromas of red berries.*
2016 Chardonnay *Produced in stainless steel tanks & unoaked, refreshingly crisp, citrusy, & floral.*
2016 Rosé *An off-dry, mouth-watering rosé of merlot. Light, lovely, and easily enjoyed.*
2010 Meritage Blend *of Cabernet Sauvignon, Petit Verdot & Merlot. Earthy, refined, & unique.*
2012 Petit Verdot *The least known of the "noble" Bordeaux varietals, Petit Verdot is traditionally reserved for blending. This one stands very well on its own with light fruit, supple earth, & fair spices.*
2016 Cabernet Sauvignon *Powerful, yet softer in tannin, fruit-forward, & approachable.*
